Admission Requirements

3. KCSE grade C or O Level Div. III and a Diploma from institutions recognized by University of Nairobi Senate.
4. KCSE grade C or O Level Div. III and a Diploma from institutions recognized by University of Nairobi Senate.
5. KACE/EAAACE Certificate with 2 Principal passes and Credit pass in Mathematics at KCE.
6. CPA/CPS Part II or equivalent qualification plus C at KCSE or O Level Div. III.
