MASTER OF ARTS IN ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Admission Requirements

- Holders of a Bachelor's degree, with a minimum of Upper Second Class Honours, or equivalent in environment, natural and social science related fields.
- Holders of Bachelor's degree, Lower Second Class, or equivalent in the areas specified in (a) above, plus a Postgraduate Diploma in a relevant field.
- Holders of Bachelors Degree, Lower Second Class, or equivalent in the areas specified above plus three years relevant experience.
- Holders of Bachelors Degree, Pass, in any of the areas specified above plus a Postgraduate Diploma in a relevant field, and two years relevant experience.
- Holders of Bachelors Degree, Pass, in the areas specified above plus five years relevant experience.

MASTER OF ARTS IN ENVIRONMENTAL LAW

Admission Requirements

- Holders of a Bachelors degree, Upper Second Class Honours, or equivalent in law, environment, physical, biological or natural resource management and/or social science related fields.
- Holders of Bachelors degree, Lower Second Class, or equivalent in the areas specified in (a) above, plus a Postgraduate Diploma in a relevant field or with two years relevant experience.
- Holders of Bachelors degree, Pass in the areas specified in (a) above plus a Postgraduate Diploma in a relevant field, and two years relevant experience.
- Holders of a Bachelors degree, pass in the areas specified in (a) above

PhD IN ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Admission requirements

The common regulations governing admission into taught PhD programmes in all Institutes, Faculties, Schools and Centres of the University of Nairobi shall apply.

- A holder of a Master of Arts degree in Environmental Policy, Environmental Law or Environmental Diplomacy from the University of Nairobi or any other institution recognized by the Senate.
- A holder of a Masters Degree in law, environmental studies or biological, natural, physical or social sciences from the University of Nairobi or any other institution recognized by the Senate.
- A holder of a doctoral degree from any institution recognized by the Senate.
- Other qualifications that may be considered acceptable to the Senate as equivalent to a Masters degree in relevant fields.

PhD IN ENVIRONMENTAL LAW

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The common regulations governing admission into taught PhD programmes in all Institutes, Faculties, Schools and Centres of the University of Nairobi shall apply.

- A holder of a Master of Arts degree in Environmental Policy, Environmental Law or Environmental Diplomacy from the University of Nairobi or any other institution recognized by the Senate.

- A holder of a Masters Degree in environmental studies, law, humanities, natural or social sciences or their equivalent from the University of Nairobi or any other institution recognized by the Senate.
- A holder of a doctoral degree in above fields from any institution recognized by the Senate.
- Other qualifications that may be considered acceptable to the Senate as equivalent to a Masters degree in relevant fields.

SCHOOL OF COMPUTING AND INFORMATICS

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN COMPUTER SCIENCE

Admission Requirements:

- Holders of Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) with a minimum aggregate qualification of C+. In addition, applicants must have obtained a minimum Grade of C+ in Mathematics and Physics.
- Candidates with 2 principal passes, one of which must be in Mathematics or Physics and a subsidiary pass, with a Credit pass in Physics at 'O' level.
- Candidates with Ordinary Diploma in Computer Studies or equivalent with a pass at Credit level, from an institution recognized by Senate.
- Candidates with Higher Diploma in Computer Studies or equivalent from an institution recognized by Senate.
- Candidates with a Bachelor's degree from an institution recognized by Senate.

MSc in APPLIED COMPUTING

Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in any Computer Science or IT related discipline, of at least Upper Second or an equivalent qualification
- Lower Second with at least 2 years of demonstrable relevant experience;
- Pass with at least 5 years of demonstrable relevant experience;
- Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science/IS of at least Credit.
- In addition, applicants shall be required to pass a School-based entrance examination.

MSc in COMPUTATIONAL INTELLIGENCE

Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, of at least Upper Second or an equivalent qualification;
- Bachelor's degree in a related Engineering, Mathematics or Statistics discipline, of at least Upper Second or an equivalent qualification;
- Lower Second with at least 2 years of demonstrable relevant experience.
- In addition, applicants shall be required to pass a School-based entrance examination.

MSC INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT

Admission Requirements:

- Bachelors degree in any Computer Science or IT or related discipline, of at least Upper Second class or an equivalent qualification
- Lower Second class with at least 2 years of demonstrable relevant IT expertise and experience
- Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science/Information Systems of at least Credit.
- In addition, applicants shall be required to pass a School-based entrance examination.

MSc in DISTRIBUTED COMPUTING TECHNOLOGY

Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in Computer Science or related disciplines (e.g. Engineering, Mathematics and Physics), of at least Upper Second or an equivalent qualification;

- Lower Second with at least 2 years of related work experience; OR Pass with at least 5 years of relevant work experience.
- In addition, applicants shall be required to pass a School-based entrance examination.

Admission Requirements

Master's degree in Computer Science or Information Systems, or an equivalent qualification from an institution recognised by Senate.
